Board of Manager's Minutes  
September 26, 2024

President, Gene Tiedemann, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. at the Red Lake Watershed District Office, Thief River Falls, MN.

Managers Present: Gene Tiedemann, Brian Dwight, LeRoy Ose, Grant Nelson, Allan Page, and Tom Anderson. Managers Absent: Terry Sorenson. Staff Present: Tammy Audette, Melissa Bushy, Erick Huseh, Tony Olson, and Legal Counsel, Delray Sparby.

The Board reviewed the agenda. A motion was made by Ose, seconded by Nelson, and passed by unanimous vote that the Board approve the agenda, as presented. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed the September 12, 2024, Board meeting minutes. Motion by Nelson, seconded by Anderson, to approve the September 12, 2024, Board meeting minutes. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed the Financial Report dated September 25, 2024. Staff member Elaine Rychlock discussed the three Edward Jones Certificate of Deposits (CDs) we have coming due in September 2024. One CD matured on September 18, 2024, with the other two CD's maturing on September 27, 2024. A motion was made by Anderson, seconded by Page, to approve the September 25, 2024, Financial Report and the purchase of two CD's at Dakota Heritage Bank in Red Lake Falls, MN: one \$500,000 Certificate of Deposit for 7 months at a rate of 5.17% and the second Certificate of Deposit for \$500,000 for 9 months at a rate of 5.25%. Motion carried.

Staff member Elaine Rychlock presented an invoice for a four-month period of Membership Dues from the League of Minnesota Cities in the amount of \$786.00. The League of Minnesota Cities voted to move to a calendar year starting January 1, 2026. To account for the adjustment, the League's Fiscal Year 2025 budget will be spread over 16 months, instead of 12 months, therefore a four-month membership is presented for approval. Motion by Nelson, seconded by Dwight to approve to pay the invoice in the amount of \$786.00. Motion carried.

Engineer Nate Dalager, HDR Engineering, Inc., and Wayne Johnson, City of Thief River Falls, appeared before the Board for discussion on the Chiefs Coulee Project, RLWD Project No. 46S. Dalager indicated that they are wrapping up the easements and permitting of the project, and would like to consider advertising for bids. Dalager asked whether the bid documents should be on behalf of the District or the City of Thief River Falls. After discussion amongst the group, motion by Dwight, seconded by Ose, that the District will complete the advertisement for bids and hold the contract for construction of the Chiefs Coulee Project, RLWD Project No. 46S. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the repairs to the Knutson Dam, RLWD Project No. 50F. Taggart Excavating has been on site working on the project.

The Board reviewed Pay Estimate No. 2 to Anderson Excavating for the Elm Lake/Farnes Pool Sluice Gate Replacement, RLWD Project No. 52 in the amount of \$25,915.02. Motion by Ose, seconded by Page, to approve the payment of Pay Estimate No. 2 to Anderson Excavating in the amount of \$25,915.02 for the Elm Lake/Farnes Pool Sluice Gate Replacement, RLWD Project No. 52. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed Pay Estimate No. 1 to Higher Ground/Paul Zavoral Inc. for the Cardinal Ring Dike, RLWD Project No. 129BB in the amount of \$19,201.02. Motion by Page, seconded by Nelson, to approve the payment of Pay Estimate No. 1 to Higher Ground Paul Zavoral Inc. in the amount of \$19,201.02 for the Cardinal Ring Dike, RLWD Project No. 129BB. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed Pay Estimate No. 1 to Olson Construction for the Payment Ring Dike, RLWD Project No. 129BC in the amount of \$65,186.34. Motion by Ose, seconded by Page, to approve the payment of Pay Estimate No. 1 to Olson Construction in the amount of \$65,186.34 for the Cardinal Ring Dike, RLWD Project No. 129BC. Motion carried.

Staff member, Tony Olson, presented pictures and discussed some unpermitted work that has occurred in Section 18, Hill River Township, Polk County. A motion was made by Nelson, seconded by Olson, for Olson to send the landowner a letter notifying him of a written warning. Motion carried.

Staff member, Tony Olson, presented pictures and discussed some unpermitted work that has occurred in Section 4, Emardville Township, Red Lake County. A motion was made by Ose, seconded by Page, for Olson to send the landowner a letter notifying him of a written warning. Motion carried.

The Board reviewed the permits for approval. Motion by Page, seconded by Anderson, to approve the following permits with conditions stated on the permit: No. 24101, Tom Oscarson, Browns Creek Township, Red Lake County; No. 24137, Robert Englund, Spruce Grove Township, Beltrami County; No. 24141, WJS Nelson, Northland Township, Polk County; No. 24142, James Reinbold, Mayfield Township, Pennington County; No. 24144, Dick Sjoberg, Whiteford Township, Marshall County; No. 24146, Trevor Berg, Whiteford Township, Marshall County; No. 24147, Jeff Scramstad, Thief Lake Township, Marshall County; No. 24148, MnDOT, Numedal Township, Pennington County; No. 24149, Zak Revocable Living Trust, Keystone Township, Polk County; 24150, Zak Revocable Living Trust, Tabor Township, Polk County; No. 24151, Daniel Cymbaluk, Parnell Township, Polk County; No. 24154, Enbridge Energy, Dudley Township, Clearwater County; and No. 24162, Gasper Family Farms, Fanny Township, Polk County. Motion carried.

Administrator Audette reviewed Pay Request 8 to the Red River Watershed Management Board (RRWMB) for construction of the Black River Impoundment, RLWD Project No. 176, in the amount of \$46,871.69. Audette noted that the final amount included \$222,445.11 in damages from the 2022 flood event. These damages were paid by FEMA, therefore the District will need

to issue a check in the amount of \$148,296.81 to the RRWMB for 66.6667% of what was originally billed to the RRWMB.

Administrator Audette discussed the November 2024 and December 2024 board meeting dates – November 14 & November 23 and December 12 & 26. November 28 is Thanksgiving Day. December 26 is the day after Christmas Day. After much discussion on choosing a new date for the second meeting in November and December, a motion was made by Ose, seconded by Dwight to change the November 28 board meeting date to November 25, 2024. Motion carried. A motion was made by Ose, seconded by Page to change the December 26, 2024, board meeting date to December 30, 2024. Motion carried.

Administrators Update:

- Administrator Audette plans to participate in a portion of the BWSR Academy. Several other District staff members will also be attending.
- Approximately 65 River Watch Students were in the office on Wednesday, September 25, to participate in the River Watch Kick-Off event.
- District staff will participate in LIDAR training offered by the International Water Institute on October 8, 2024.
- Included in the packet was the July 2024 RLWD Newsletter.

Manager Dwight shared that the comment period for the Upper/Lower Red Lake 1W1P ends September 30.

Motion by Page, seconded by Dwight, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.

A report was presented on JD 4, RLWD Project 101, by Staff member Christina Slowinski. Slowinski stated the last maintenance completed on the system was cattail spraying in 2015. She went on to explain various deficiencies she and Nick Olson had observed upon their inspection of the system. It appeared that a four-wheeler trail/dike had been constructed across a portion of the drainage system and by utilizing Google maps along with windshield inspection, it appeared there are approximately 20+ beaver dams in the system. Slowinski's recommendation was to hold a landowner meeting to discuss the present condition of the ditch system and to share with them the maintenance that may have to be had as well as hearing of any damages that may be occurring to lands benefitted by the system. After considerable discussion by the Board, the consensus was to hold a landowner meeting this coming winter and get input from the landowners and their direction on future maintenance on the system.

Legal Counsel Delray Sparby gave a legal update on RLWD Ditch 17, RLWD Proj. 179.

Additional discussion on Thief River Westside FDR, RLWD Proj. 178, construction was held. Pennington County asked to do a change order for the culvert on County Ditch 61, a change order was completed and approved by the Board, but Zavorals have not signed the \$39,000 change order due to the fact they did not want the work days for that structure to be held against them. Dave Zavoral had asked if he should attend the next Board meeting. Administrator Jesme stated there is considerable work to be completed by next Board meeting but the hopes are the project will be substantially completed by that time.

Red Lake SWCD has requested 2020 Project 164, Erosion Control Funds, for the following individual projects:

The total cost for the Ray Delorme Grade Stabilization Project is \$7,335.59 with a request from RLWD for \$1,000 cost share for the Project. Motion by Page, seconded by Ose, and passed unanimously to approve the cost share of \$1,000 to Red Lake SWCD for the Ray Delorme project.

The total cost for the Dave Ste Marie Grade Stabilization Project is \$10,921.43 with a request from RLWD for \$1,630.00 cost share for the Project. Motion by Page, seconded by Dwight, and passed unanimously to approve the cost share of \$1,630.00 to Red Lake SWCD for the Dave Ste Marie project.

The total cost for the Ralph Perreault, Gervais Township, Grade Stabilization Project is \$12,621.12 with a request from RLWD for \$7,521.00 cost share for the Project. Motion by Page, seconded by Tiedemann, and passed unanimously to approve the cost share of \$7,521.00 to Red Lake SWCD for the Ralph Perrault project.

Staff member Nick Olson discussed presented permit No. 20-052, Tim Chaput, to the Board for discussion. Mr. Chaput had applied to clean the road ditch to improve drainage to the East. Mr. Chaput's claim was the water drained to the west prior to Red Lake County's road improvement in 2001. At that time, he claimed there had been a culvert in his crossing that let water go west. Olson stated that Red Lake County's Road Plan from 2001 called for a culvert in the now dry

crossing, thus letting water go west and not east. Olson had stated to Mr. Chaput that if a culvert was found in the crossing, the permit would be approved to replace the culvert thus allowing the water to go west as no permit is on record at the District to bury the existing culvert if there indeed is one, in accordance with Red Lake County's 2001 road plan. Consensus of the Board to allow Mr. Chaput to drain west should he find a culvert.

The Board reviewed the permits for approval. Motion by Ose, seconded by Tiedemann, to approve the following permits with conditions stated on the permit: No. 20-188, Monte Casavan, Red Lake Falls Township, Red Lake; No. 20-205, Pennington County Highway Department, Star Township, Pennington County; No. 20-209, Willis R. Ihrke, Columbia Township, Polk County; No. 20-212, Delores V. Schulz, Belgium Township, Polk County; No. 20-218, John Swanson, Grove Park Township, Polk County; No. 20-219, Gary Grove, Gervais Township, Red Lake County; No. 20-220, Daniel S. Administrator Jesme stated he did not have a report for the Board.

Legal Counsel Sparby updated the Board on the Notice of Appeal for RLWD Ditch No. 17, RLWD Project No. 179.

In Managers' updates, Tiedemann inquired about Burnham Creek discussion that previously was had with Jerome Simmons and Robin Brekken. Torgerson asked if there was a record of operations on Little Pine Lake to which Administrator Jesme stated that staff member Dave Marshall is monitoring it and it is currently at winter level. The status of the floating bogs on Little Pine Lake was asked by Nelson.

Motion by Sorenson, seconded by Torgerson, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.

Staff member Nick Olson and Dave Marshall presented constructions plans for modifications to the Brandt Impoundment, RLWD Project No. 60D, on property owned by Ron Salentine. Olson discussed installation of two berms that would stop water from breaking out onto Salentine's property, installation of culvert at the extension of the berm and lowering of the emergency spillway by one foot. Landowner, Ron Salentine, stated that the flowage easement he has with the District is at an elevation of 1916.0, with the emergency spillway at an elevation of 1917. Mr. Salentine is requesting a flowage easement up to 1917.0. Motion by Tiedemann, seconded by Ose, to grant authority to Administrator Jesme to negotiate a rate per acre for a flowage easement with Mr. Salentine up to an elevation of 1917.0, for the Brandt Impoundment, RLWD Project No. 60D and report back to the Board. Motion carried.

Landowners Tim Chaput, George Proulx and Randy Proulx appeared before the Board for discussion on RLWD Permit No. 20052, Tim Chaput, Lake Pleasant Township, Red Lake County. Following discussion with the landowners, motion by Torgerson, seconded by Tiedemann, to approve RLWD Permit No.

20052, Tim Chaput, Lake Pleasant Township, directing George and Randy Proulx to remove the berm placed in the field ditch, to allow Mr. Chaput's water to drain west. Motion carried.

Administrator Jesme stated that he will be participating in a conference call with the staff from the NRCS to negotiate the grant match for the Black River Impoundment Project, RLWD Project No. 176. Jesme stated that he will request the land acquisition, engineering and design and potentially permitting to be included in the match. Motion by Tiedemann, seconded by Ose, to authorize Administrator Jesme the authority to sign the NRCS grant for the Black River Impoundment, RLWD Project No. 176. Jesme reported that District staff and Legal Counsel Sparby are reviewing R.Z. Zavoral and Sons, Inc. contract documents. A preconstruction meeting will be held on October 14, 2020. Legal Counsel Sparby stated that he had met with landowner Steve Sorvig regarding drafting of an easement.

The Board reviewed Pay Estimate No. 11 in the amount of \$1,068,134.22 to R.J. Zavoral & Sons, Inc. for construction of the Thief River Falls Westside Flood Damage Reduction Project, RLWD Project No. 178. Motion by Ose, seconded by Page, to approve Pay Estimate No. 11 in the amount of \$1,068,134.22 to R.J. Zavoral & Sons, Inc., for construction of the Thief River Falls Westside Flood Damage Reduction Project, RLWD Project No. 178. Motion carried. Motion by Sorenson, seconded by Torgerson, to approve amending Change Order No. 6, to R.J. Zavoral and Sons, Inc., reflecting a completion date of November 1, 2020 for installation of the 6<sup>th</sup> Street box culvert for the Thief River Falls Westside Flood Damage Reduction Project, RLWD Project No. 178. Motion carried. Dave Zavoral and Nick Carlien, R.J. Zavoral & Sons, Inc., reported that topsoil is being spread, touch up work was being done around culverts, gravel is being placed on roads, and 80% of the outlet has been seeded. Mark Borseth and Wayne Johnson, City of Thief River Falls, stated that they were pleased with the construction progress over the last several weeks. Discussion was held on the ditch along Highway 32 on the Timm property line; with a 10:1 slope and concern of the narrowness of the area and location of the pipes. President Nelson stated that rock will need to be removed on the temporary right-of-way areas.

Motion by Ose, seconded by Tiedemann, to authorize President Nelson, the authority to sign the RRWMB Water Quality Program Grant Agreement for the Thief River Falls Oxbow Project, RLWD Project No. 46Q. Motion carried.

Administrator Jesme reported that the NRCS approved the replacement of the BR-6 (Burnham Creek) Outlet Structure, RLWD Project No. 43A. Construction inspection will be performed by Loren Sanderson.

Administrator Jesme informed the Board, that the redetermination of benefits hearing for Judicial Ditch 72, RLWD Project No. 41 will be delayed until this winter to allow Polk County time to

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

This public hearing will be on **Tuesday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024 at 9:00AM at the Seven Clans Casino** Red Lake (10200 Highway 89 Redlake, MN 56671).

After nearly two years of collaborative planning, the comprehensive watershed management plan is nearly complete. This watershed plan aligns water planning along watershed boundaries and enhances existing county water plans. It sets goals and actions for the next 10 years to help prioritize and fund projects with the purpose of maintaining and improving water quality in this area.

This voluntary program is administered through the Board of Water and Soil Resources. Red Lake Nation and Beltrami SWCD teamed up to develop this plan. A voluntary technical advisory committee helped develop the Plan. Partners will complete plan action items that are measurable and trackable to improve and protect soil and water in this area.
